LAMBCO has also produced *Do You Have A Secret Crush? (Sleeping with Straight Men)* (Lost Theatre); five Christmas skating events (Torquay); *Bluebirds* (Above The Stag); *Sincerely Yours* and associate producer for *Bewitchment on Black Ice* (Landor), *Boys in the Buff* and *Skin Deep*, both of which received 5 Star Reviews. *Skin Deep* then went on a National Tour and the Edinburgh Fringe Festival gaining another 5 Star Review and a Fringe Award from Scots Gay, *The Crumple Zone* and *Margot, Dame, the Most Famous Ballerina in the World* (King's Head Theatre).

At the Drayton Arms Theatre and Ed Fest, LAMBCO produced *Boys in the Buff, Tickle, Soho Boy, Bette Midler and Me, Twinkle* and *Love is Blue.* Playbill chose *Boys In The Buff* as their "pick of the fringe" and the Scotsman declared *Tickle* and *Boys In The Buff*, two of the Fringe's four sexiest musicals.

At the Stage Door Theatre, LAMBCO has produced *Marry Me a Little, The Tailor-Made Man, Slices of Life* and this UK premiere of the Broadway musical *The Story Of My Life*.


